# Salem County Clean Communities Clean-Up Grant

Your Group can earn money to support your non-profit group activities and learn an important environmental lesson at the same time by applying for a Salem County Clean Communities Clean-Up Grant! These grants are a great way for your group to provide community service and to clean our county roads of unsightly litter.

Your non-profit group may be approved to clean-up a 2 mile stretch of a county road on one of the Saturdays in the month of May, earning \$300.00 for your group. The money for the clean ups is provided by a Clean Communities Grant from the State of New Jersey.



## Frequently asked questions:

### 1. What are the requirements to participate in the clean-ups?

*Groups must be a non-profit organization with a bank account in the groups' name.*

### 2. How many people do I need in my group?

*Groups must have at least 10 members that are participating in the clean-up. For every 5 participants under the age of 18, there must be at least 1 supervisor over the age of 18.*

### 3. Can my group do more than one clean-up?

*No, groups may only participate in one clean-up.*

### 4. When are the clean-ups?

*The clean-ups are held on consecutive Saturdays in the month of May, between the hours of 8am and 3pm.*

### 5. How do I get a Certificate of Liability?

*Certificates of liability can be obtained by calling your group's insurance company. This is not your insurance policy. SCIA/SWD must be named as the leinholder on the certificate of liability.*

### 6. Do I get to choose the location for the clean-up?

*No, you may select the municipality but the road locations are assigned by the Clean Communities Coordinator or personnel from the Solid Waste Division that assist her. You do however, get to choose which Saturday to have your clean-up so you can schedule with your group.*

### 7. What does our group do with the trash/recyclables after we clean the road?

*The trash and recyclables must be separated and placed either curbside or taken to your local convenience center where the groups supervisor or participants live. If trash is brought to the SCIA/Solid Waste Division there will be a charge.*
